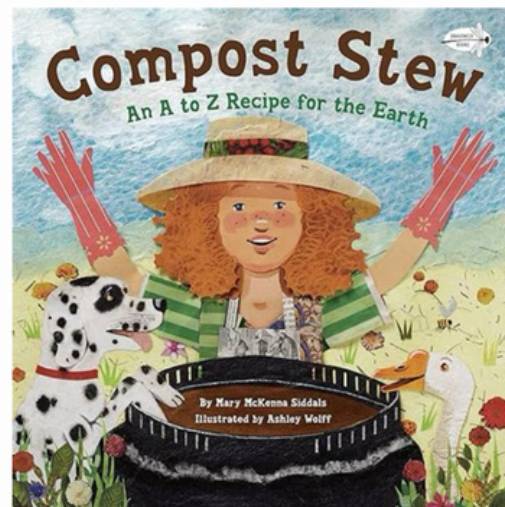
Our students continue to shine by following classroom rules, showing kindness, and being great friends to one another.
