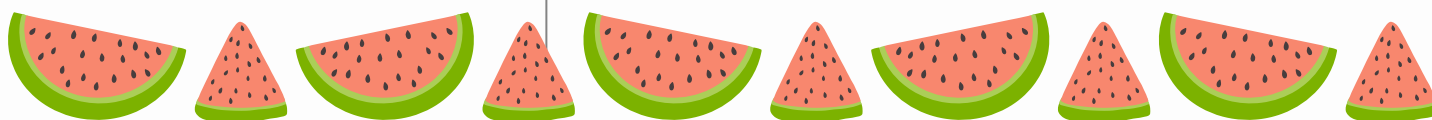

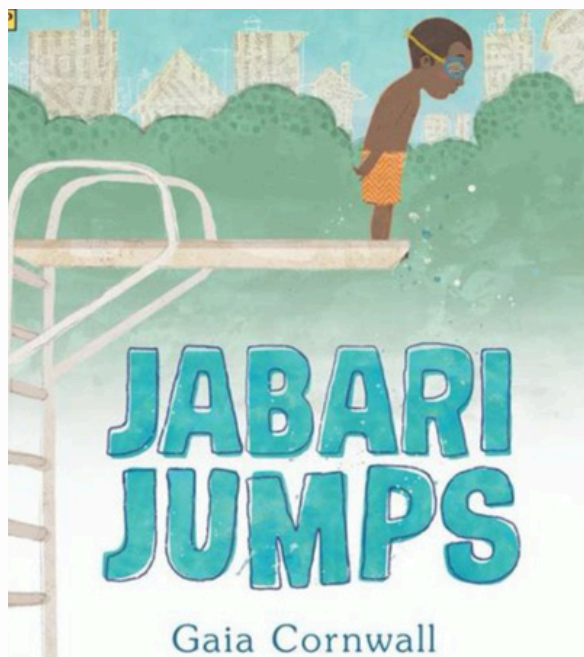




STUDENT ACHIEVEMENTS
